SPACE PLANNING

DO's

- DO give every space a purpose Storage, pet suite, domestic suite
- DO create personal escapes
 Loft for kids, balcony oasis for parents
- DO maximize your bathrooms using an open shower concept with free standing tub

DONT 's

- DON'T waste space because it seems too small to use
- DON'T use only traditional doors. Pocket and barn doors are great space savers
- DON'T forget about designated storage





FINISHES

DO's DO keep lines simple and clean

• DO use light and bright colors, like white, for cabinets and countertops

• DO choose counters with reflective qualities

- DO choose more decorative fixtures and sinks
- DON'T break the line of sight, keep the island a
- consistent height
- DON'T break up the flooring to define spaces. Continues flooring enlarges the space
- DON'T use large heavy lighting, keep it airy
- DON'T use dark woods, they enclose the space

DESIGN DETAILS



- DO create a drama point for the entry space
- DO draw focus with simple, white molding details
- DO create mirror wall details
- DO use full wall tile details in bathrooms

DONT 's

- DON'T close the space with an intricate ceiling detail
- \bullet DON'T use thick and heavy window treatments
- DON'T create heavy built-ins, use floating shelves instead
- DON'T use matte paint. Semi-glass offers a subtle reflectiveness





FURNISHINGS

DO's • DO choose multi-purpose furnishings

- DO use furniture on taller legs to create a lighter feeling
- DO choose furniture with light wood, mirrored, or metallic finishes

• DO use glass or metallic lamps

- DONT 's
 DON'T put bulky items together; pair a reading chair with whispy side table
- DON'T create a large closest space with only a single level wire rack
- DON'T use heavy ornately framed artwork. Keep frames thin and modern
