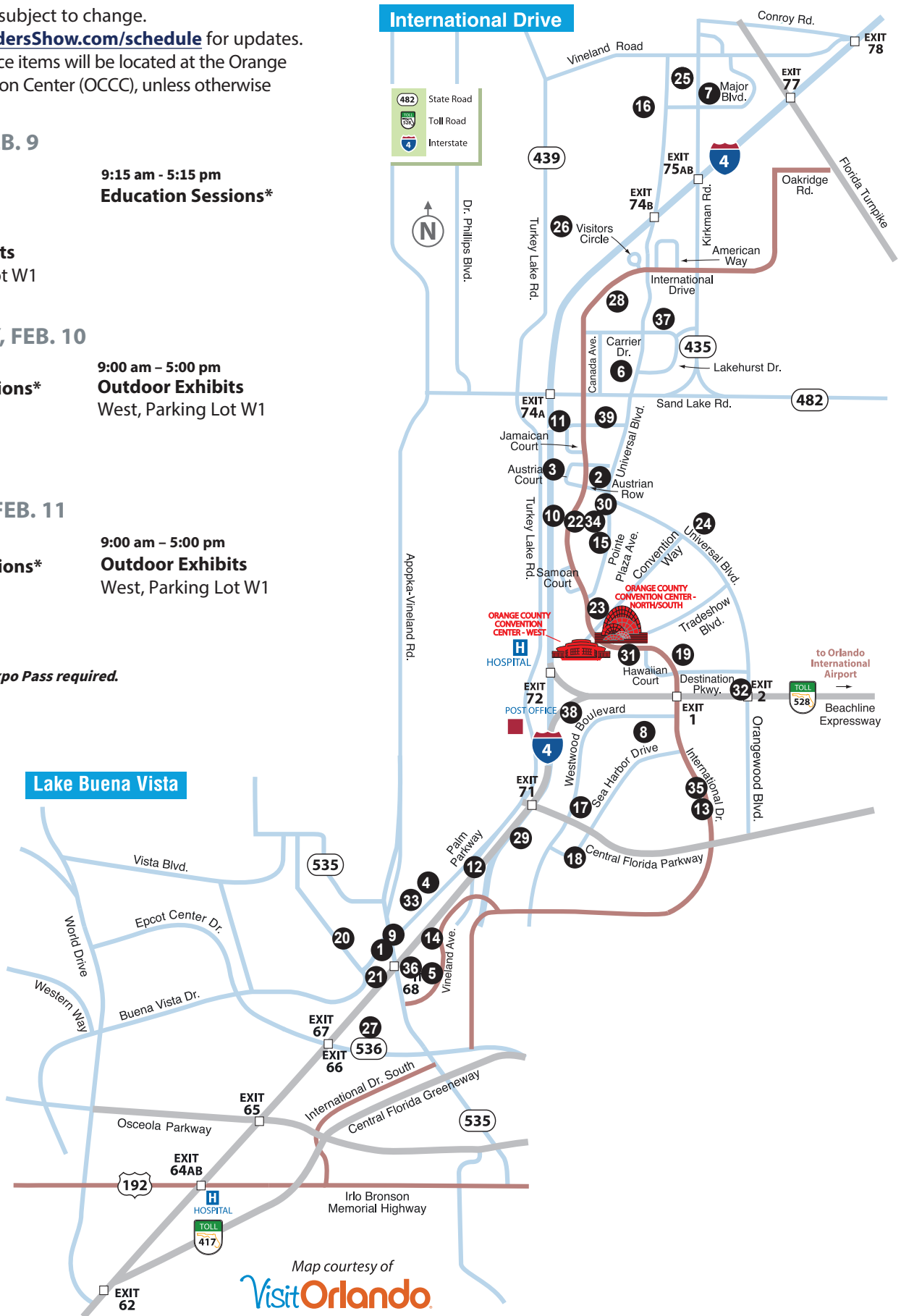

In order to be placed in a state/local association block, hotel accommodations must be requested in the assigned property on or before December 11, 2020. Assignment in state/local HBA hotels is not guaranteed due to the limited availability in each property.
